The Modern Slavery Act 2015 came into force on 29 October 2015 and requires businesses in scope to produce an annual statement setting out the steps they have taken to ensure that there is no modern slavery in their own business or in any of their supply chains. Modern slavery includes slavery, servitude and forced or compulsory labour and human trafficking.

Alvento Capital Partners LLP (“Alvento”) is a UK-based limited liability partnership whose sole business activity is investment management.

Alvento has given careful consideration to Section 54 (Transparency in Supply Chains) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015. Alvento sources its services almost entirely from the UK and other low-risk countries such as Ireland and the United States of America where modern slavery is not prevalent. Its review has concluded that the services it provides are very unlikely to be affected by slavery, as are the supply chains of those it uses for the purchase of services. Accordingly, it has been deemed unnecessary for Alvento to take any further action in respect of this legislation at this time.

Alvento does not condone any activity which constitutes a criminal and/or civil offence.

The effectiveness of the steps taken by Alvento to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in its business or supply chain will be kept under periodic review.

This statement is also in respect of its corporate member, Alvento Capital Partners (UK) Limited.

The partners of Alvento Capital Partners LLP approved this statement on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2020 in respect of financial year end 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
